

Article 1

In the framework of Regulation (EC) N° 614/2007 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 May 2007 concerning the Financial Instrument for the Environment (LIFE+) the Commission has decided to award a grant under the terms and conditions set out in the Special Provisions, the Common Provisions and the Annexes to the grant agreement, for the project entitled "Securing prey sources for endangered Falco cherring and Aquila heliaca population in the Carpathian basin" ("the project") as described in Annex I.

With the signature of the grant agreement, the coordinating beneficiary and any associated beneficiary where relevant accept the grant and agree to implement the project, acting on their own responsibility.

Two identical copies of the grant agreement have been produced, each signed by the Commission and the coordinating beneficiary.

Article 2

The grant agreement shall enter into force on the date when the last of the two parties signs.

The project shall run from 01.07.2014 to 31.12.2018.

The grant shall be of a maximum amount of $\leq 2,160,932$ and shall take the form of reimbursement of 75% of the eligible costs actually incurred for the project, which are estimated at $\leq 2,881,243$.

The final amount of the grant is determined as defined in Article 23 of the Common Provisions.
